

St. Gerard Majella Masking Update

Dear Parents,

I hope this information finds you and your family well. As you know we have for the last several weeks been in optional/situational masking at school. There were several classes who felt they needed it, but have come to find out that it is no longer necessary.

So beginning tomorrow, March 1, 2022 masking at St. Gerard Majella is Tier 1, optional masking. We will not require a child to wear a mask for any class or small group, unless the parent requires it or the child feels more comfortable wearing a mask. We will not be checking if a student is to be or not to be masked. Masking is between the child and parent.

In the event of an exposure at school, the parents of the class will be notified and we will follow the protocols sent out earlier. We have not had a school exposure or had to report a covid case in the past four weeks.

In two weeks we have spring break and as always, many of you will be heading out of town. Please do not get complacent, we are not out of the woods yet. I do not want to revert back to masking because of spring break.
