PASSWORD CHOSEN: You will then be prompted to submit information for a background screening, register for a Protecting God's Children workshop*, view two online training modules, and agree to the Code of Ethical Conduct. *If you have previously attended a PGC workshop, the system will find and/or ask you to confirm your previous record of attendance. You will not be prompted to register for an upcoming workshop. If, for some reason, it does not match your previous training to this account and you are prompted to register for a class, please register for "PREVIOUSLY AT-TENDED-DATE NOT LISTED". We will apply the correct training record to your account. You may use the links in your approval checklist to access these requirements. These steps may be completed all at Register onto the site once or may be completed separately at your convenience. Submit New Background Check You will receive an automated email weekly to remind you Complete "Protecting God's Children" training which requirements are outstanding. When all compliance Complete "Mandated Reporter" training requirements have been completed, your account will be Complete "Code of Conduct" training approved and you will be clear to work with minors and Sign "Code of Conduct" vulnerable adults.

Safe Environment (Protecting God's Children)

The Prevent and Protect STL document will guide you through the process for becoming compliant.

- Each individual will be required to complete a background check, participate in a Protecting God's Children Workshop if you have not done so, view the two video modules, and sign the Code of Ethics.
- The password for the Prevent and Protect registration site is sltprotect
- At times the system will hang when completing the background check process. The
 message indicates that it could take 3 minutes. Some have experienced that it seems
 to take longer. When they exit that screen and come back into the system the
 background check was marked as complete.
